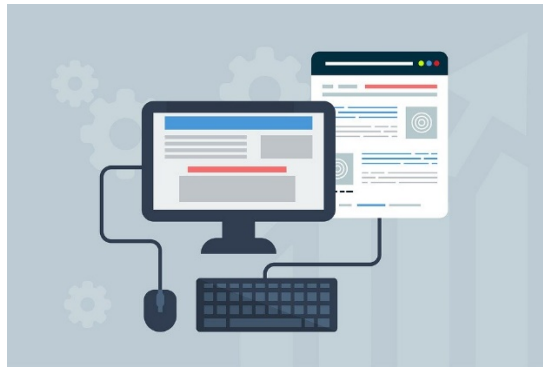

## CREATING A NAVIGATION BAR USING CSS AND HTML – TASKS

Here is an example of a simple but effective navigation bar

You can hover over to see the dropdown part work

### TASK 1: SEEING THE WHAT THE NAVIGATION BAR DOES

- Open the file called index.html in a web browser to see it how it works

### TASK 2: EDITING THE CODE

- Open the index.html in a text editor eg. Notepad++ or web authoring software such as Adobe Dreamweaver or Microsoft Expression Web (make sure code view is selected)

### TASK 3: GETTING USED TO EDITING AND USING THE CODE...

- Change the colour of the 'bar'
- Change the colour of the highlight when you hover over the navigation bar
- Change the colour of the text within the navigation bar
- Change the colour of the background of the dropdown menu
- Change the colour of the text in the dropdown menu
- Change the links

### TASK 4: ONCE YOU ARE MORE CONFIDENT...

- Create a webpage with a drop-down menu from scratch by creating the CSS first then the menu items
- Use the menu on other webpages

As with all code there are other ways to customise the menu – do some online searches for CSS Dropdown menu and see what you find to help you improve the menu...
