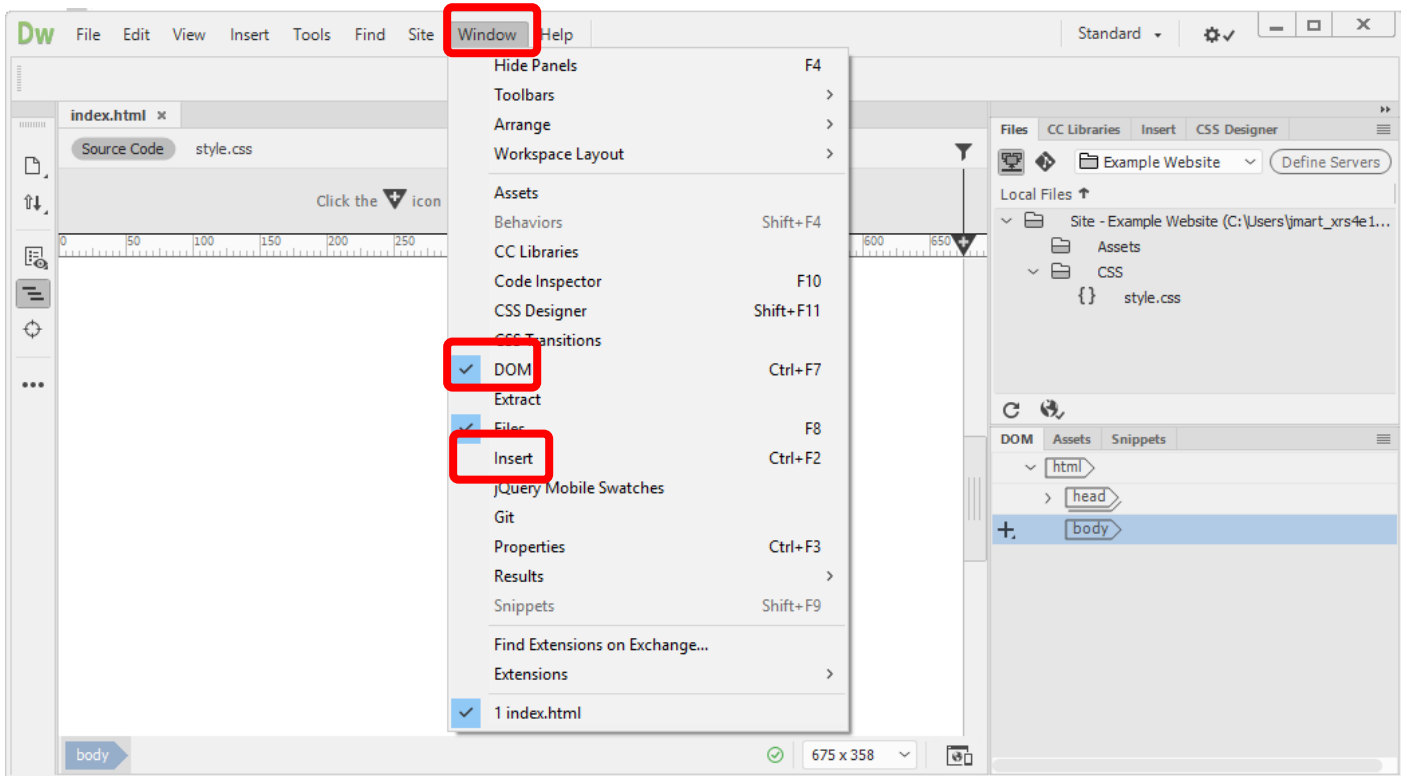


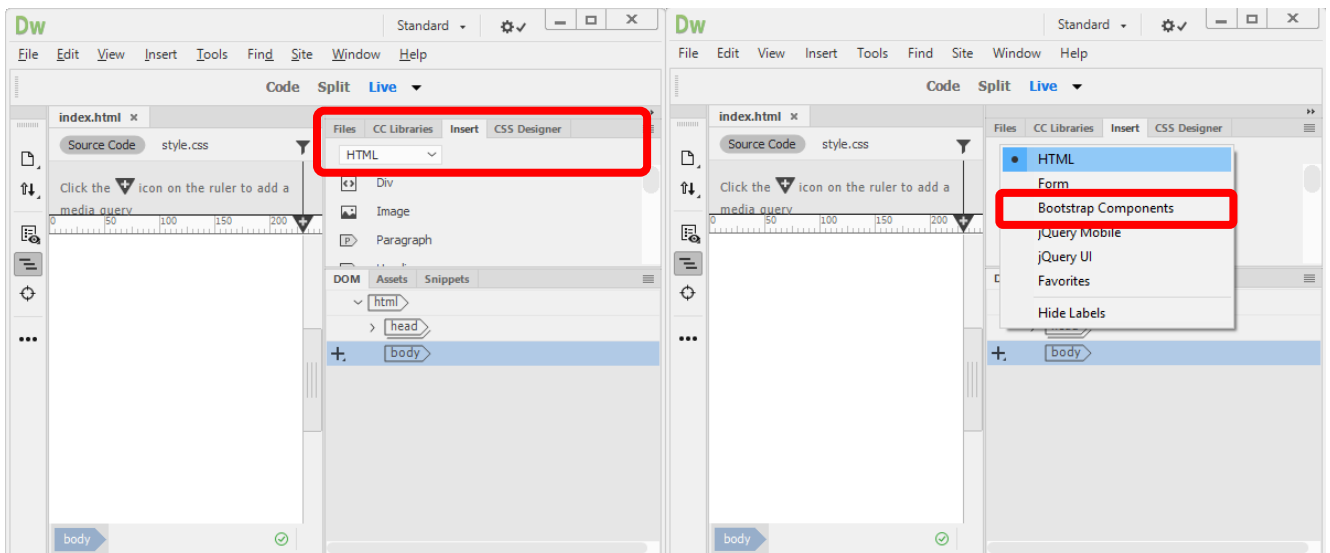
**STEP 1 – MAKE SURE YOU HAVE THE INSERT & DOM (DOCUMENT OBJECT MODEL) PANELS**

- Make sure the **Insert** and **DOM** panels is visible in your **Dreamweaver Workspace**
- Click on **Window** then **Insert** if you don't have either and they should appear on the right-hand side



**STEP 2 – ENABLING BOOTSTRAP COMPONENTS**

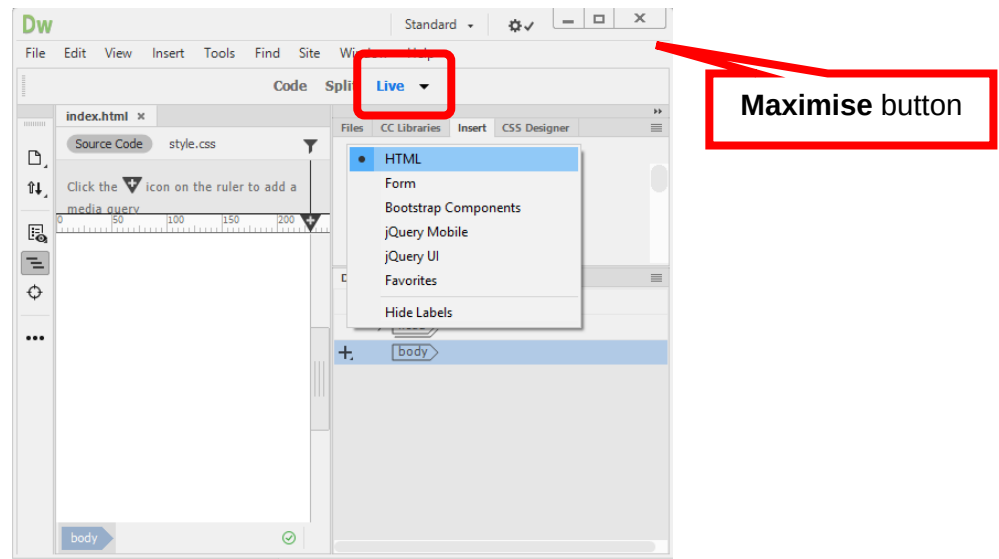
- Click on the drop-down menu that says **HTML** and change it to **Bootstrap Components**



*Bootstrap components are free open source CSS bits of code (originally created by a developer at Twitter) that provide you with design templates for typography, forms, buttons, navigation and other interface components.*

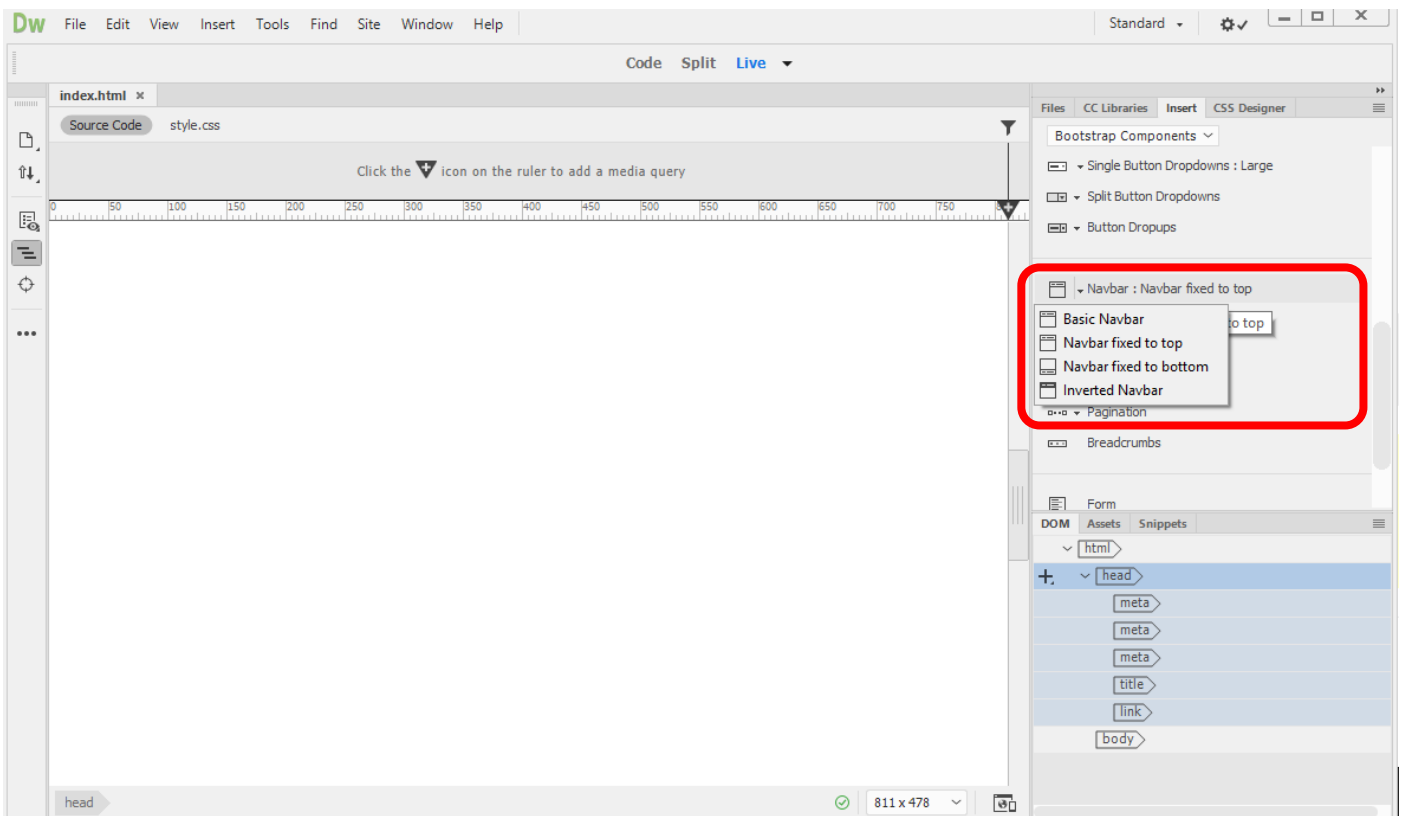
**STEP 3 – CHECK WHAT STATE DREAMWEAVER IS IN**

- Make sure you are in **Live** mode
- Make sure your Dreamweaver application is **maximised** (else you will see the mobile view!)



**STEP 4 – ADDING A NAVIGATION BAR**

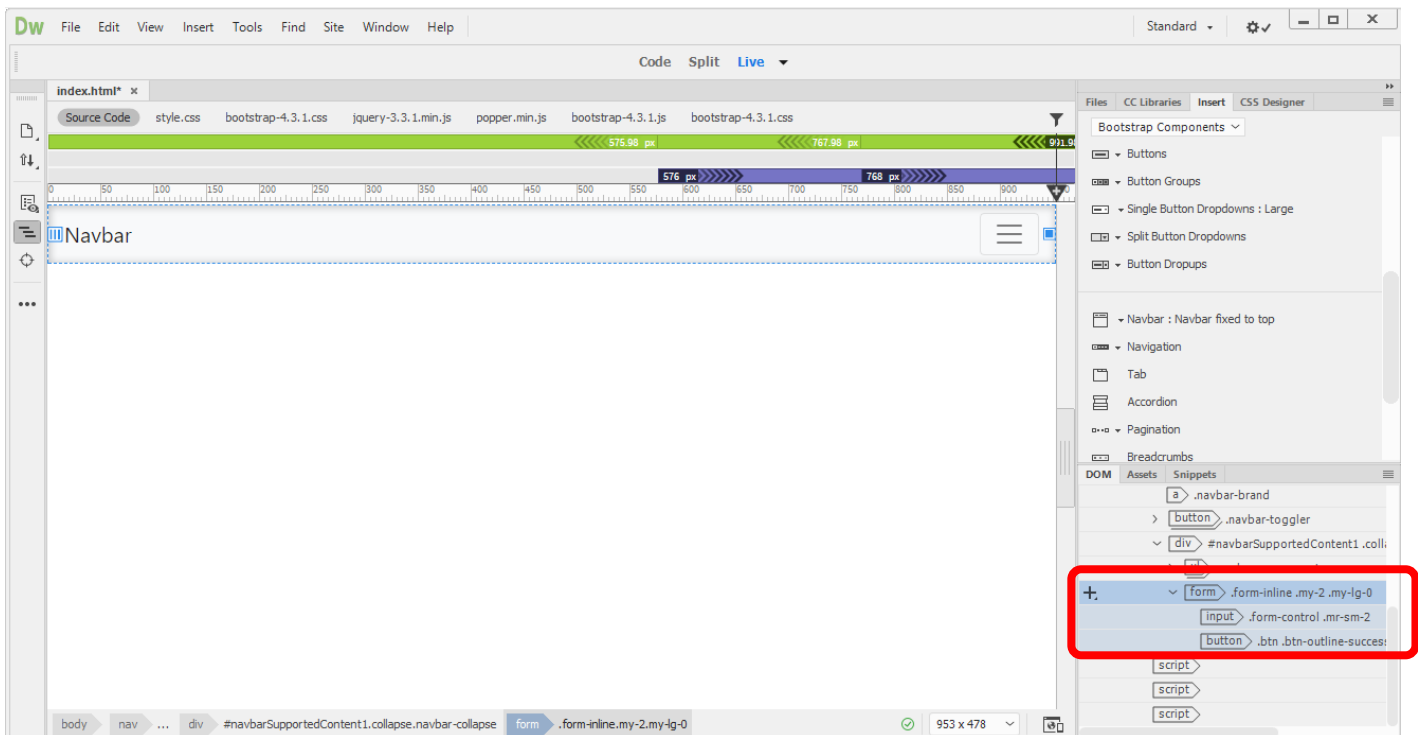
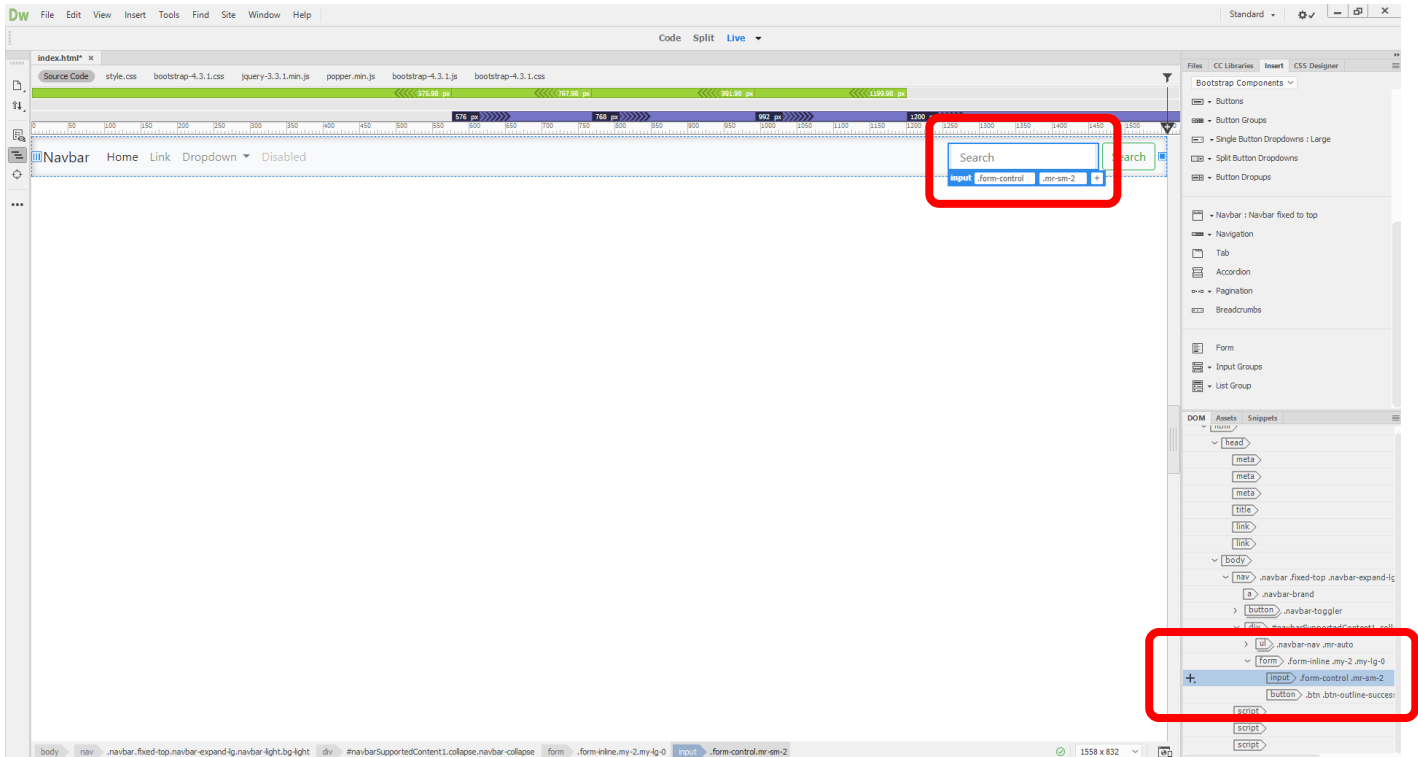
- Under the **Insert** menu choose **Navbar fixed to top**



STEP 5 – DELETING THE SEARCH BOX

As your website will not be on a server you can delete this box...

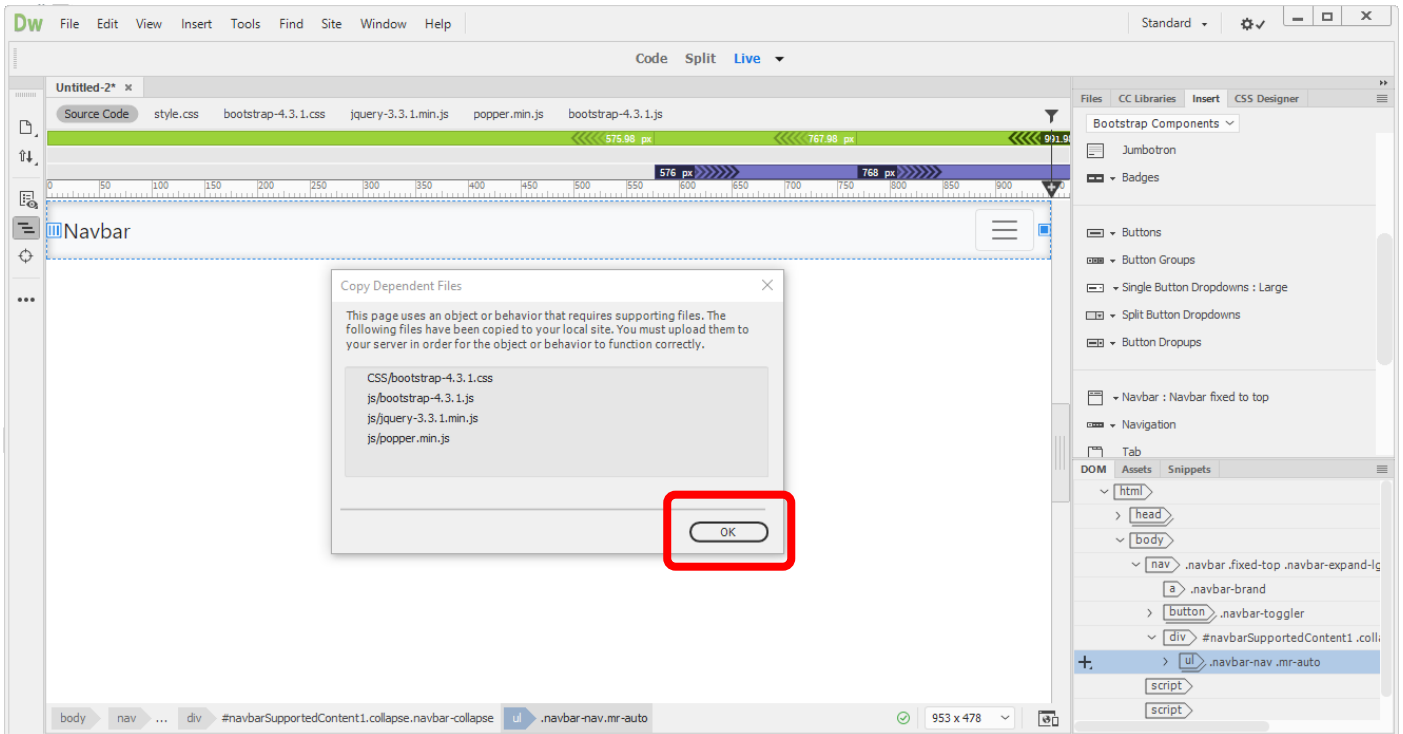
- Left-click inside the **Search** box at the top of the page
- Left-click on Form in the **DOM Panel** and it will go blue
- Either right-click and choose **Delete** or press the **Delete** key on your keyboard



**STEP 6 – SAVING**

*It is worth saving at this point, just in case!*

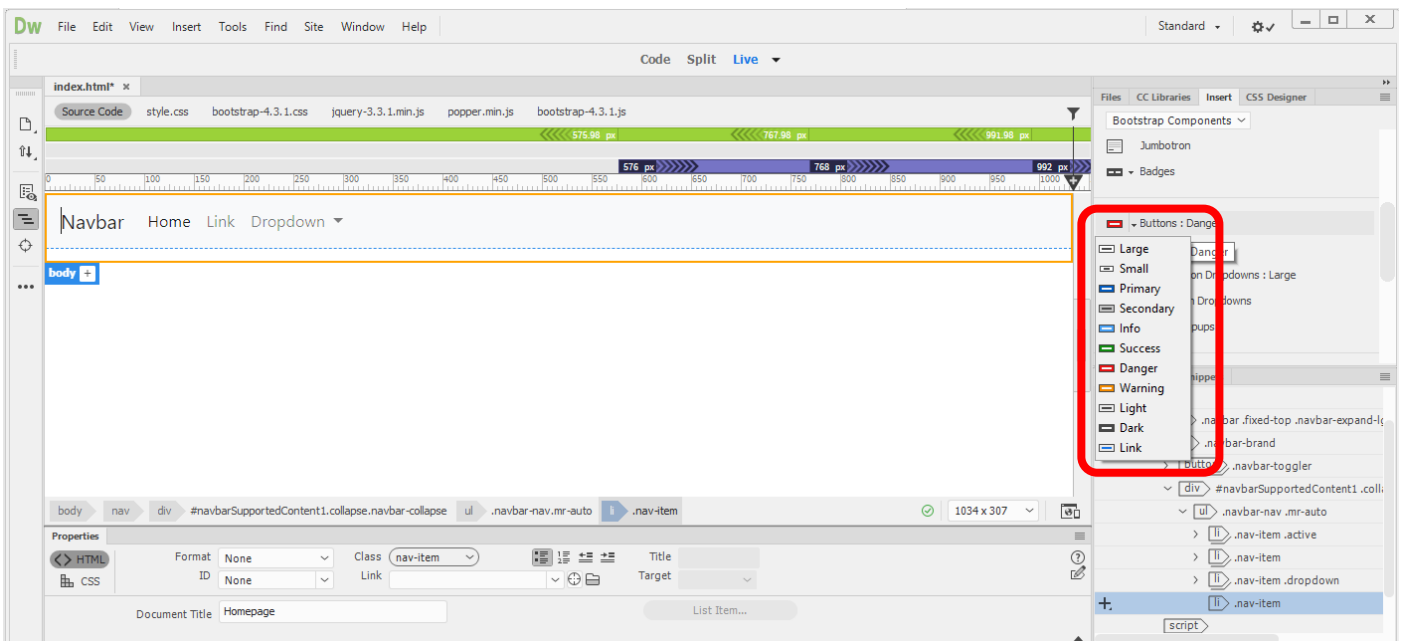
- When you save you will be asked to save additional file that make your navigation bar work
- Press **OK** and do NOT press the X



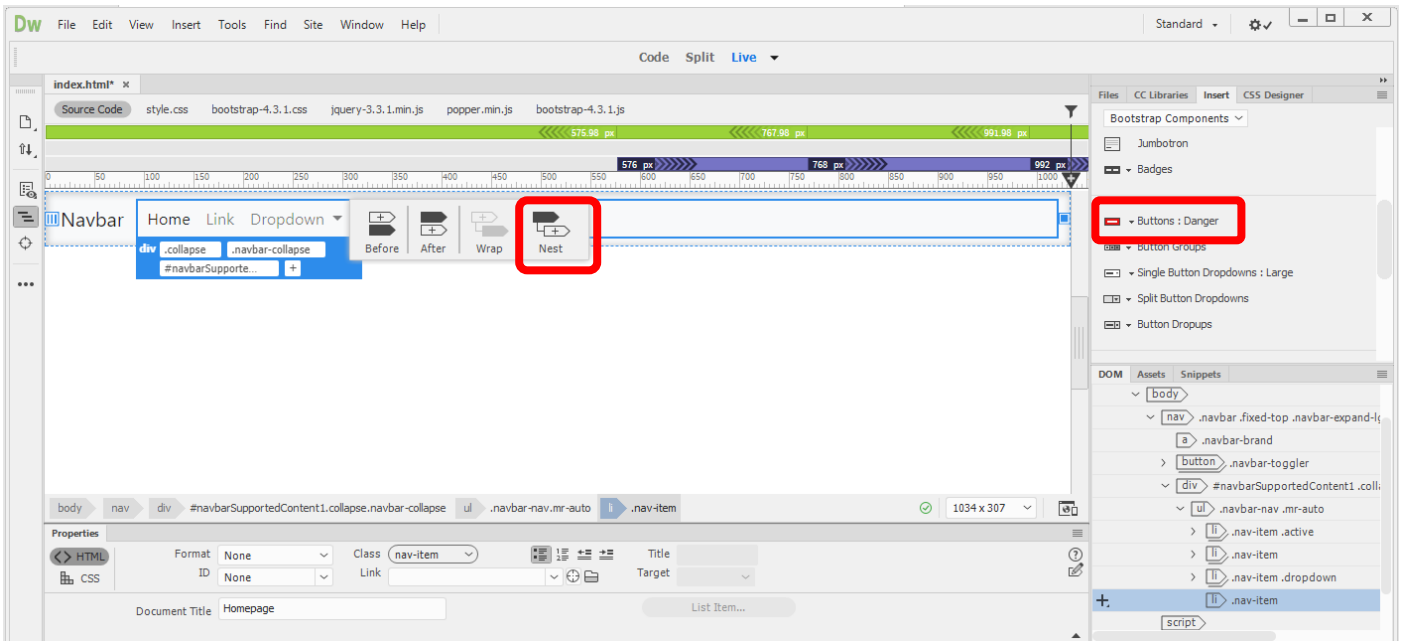
**STEP 8 – CREATING THE BUTTONS**

There are some buttons with rollovers built in...

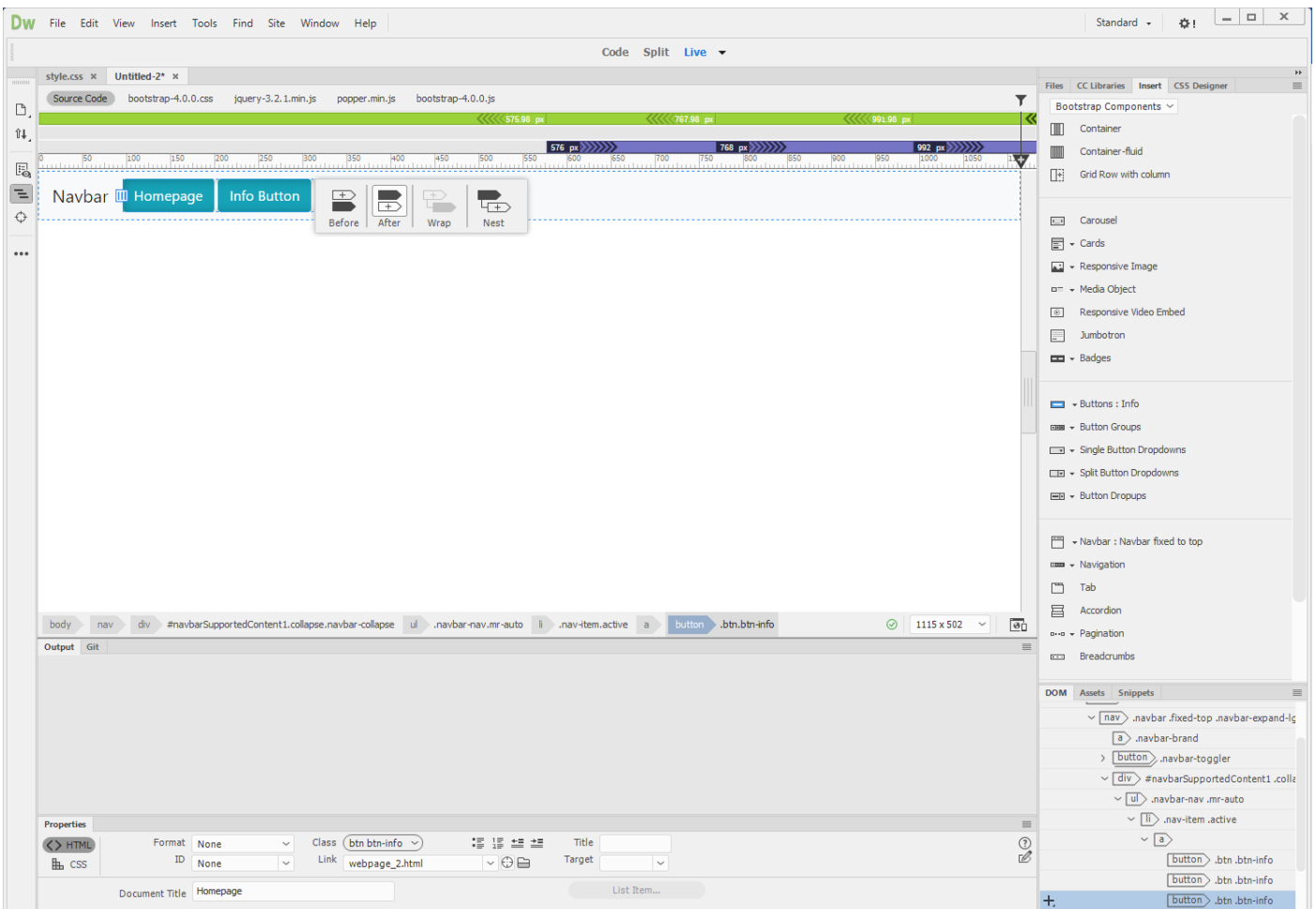
- Delete any links you have and then click on **Buttons** in the **Bootstrap** menu



- Choose **Nest** (the buttons will appear in reverse order) then customise the text



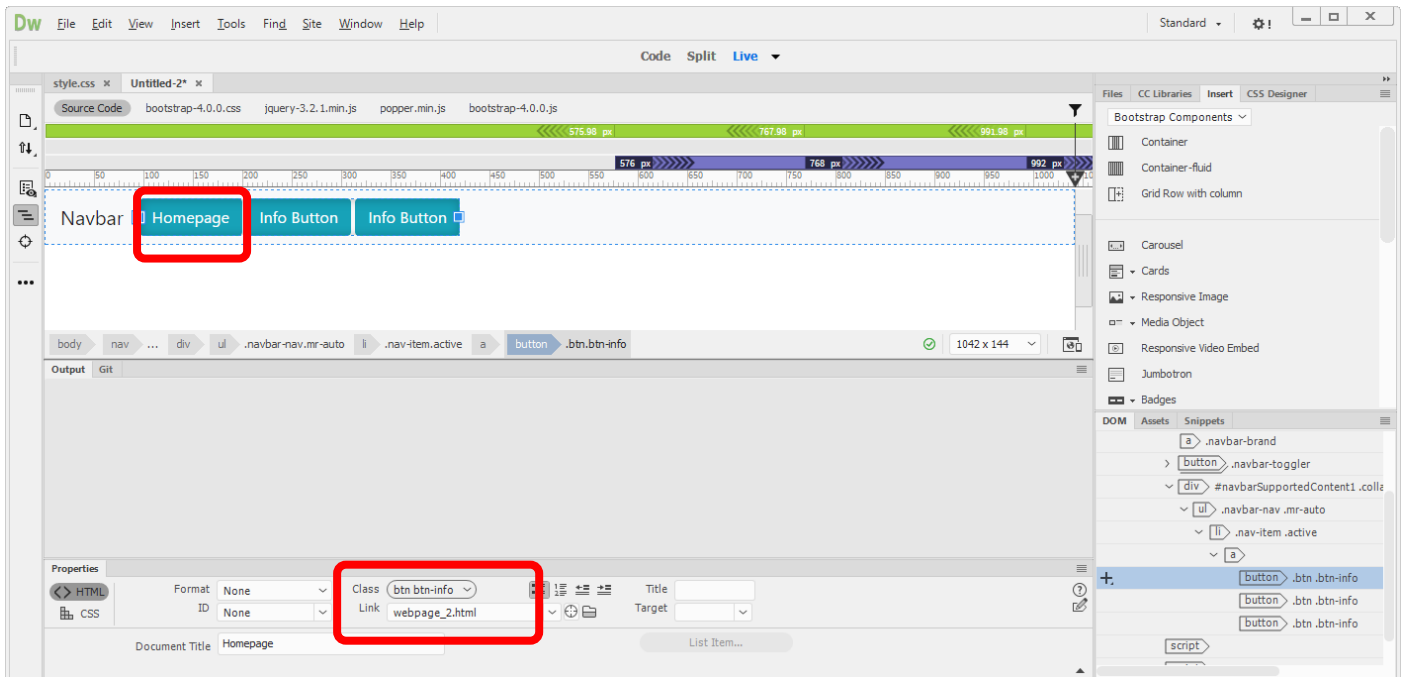
- For subsequent buttons make sure you choose **After** so there is a little gap



*If you haven't already you can delete the original text by clicking on it and checking in the DOM panel for it and then right-clicking and deleting it.*

### STEP 9 – ADDING THE HYPERLINKS

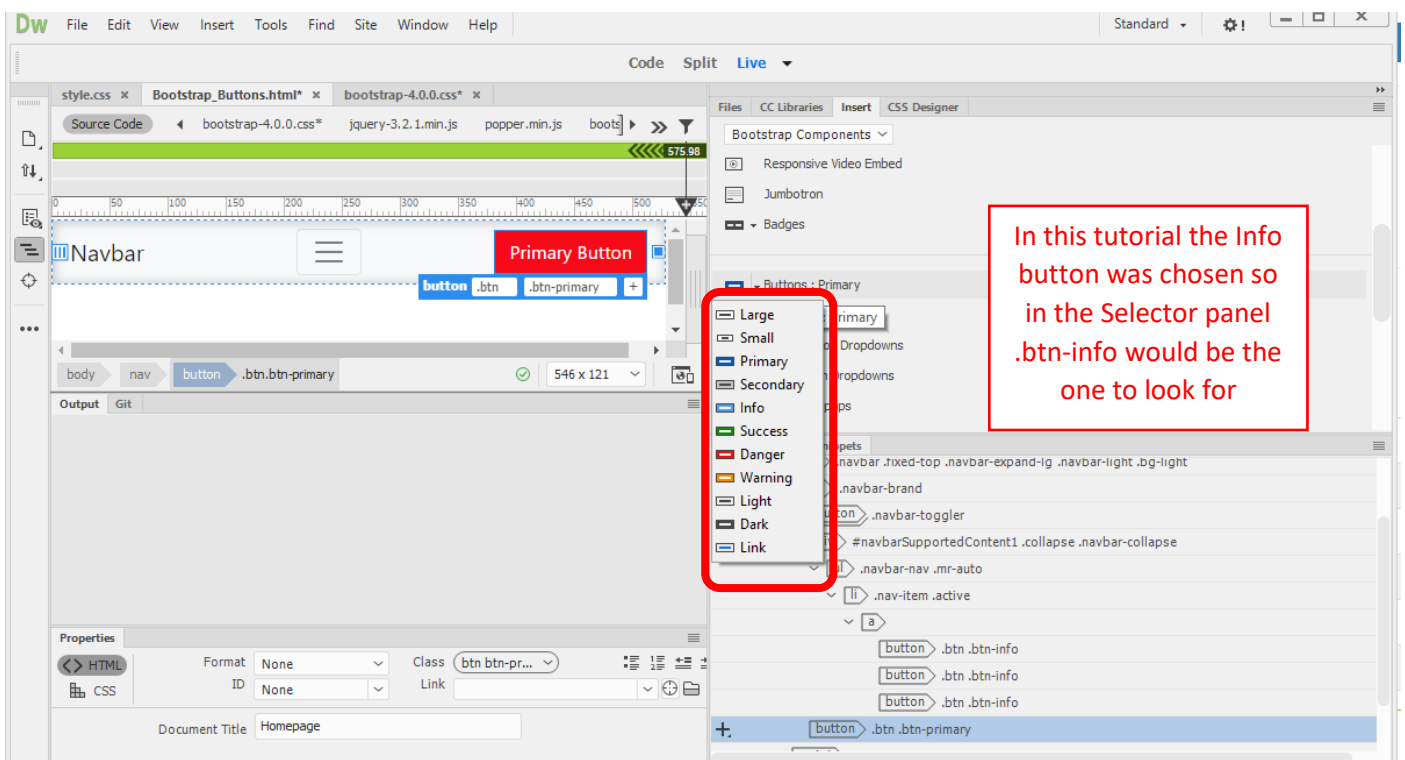
- To add the hyperlinks, select a left-click on a button and then either type the webpage address or click on the folder to find it
- To make the hyperlink open in a new window, chose **\_blank** in the **Target** section.



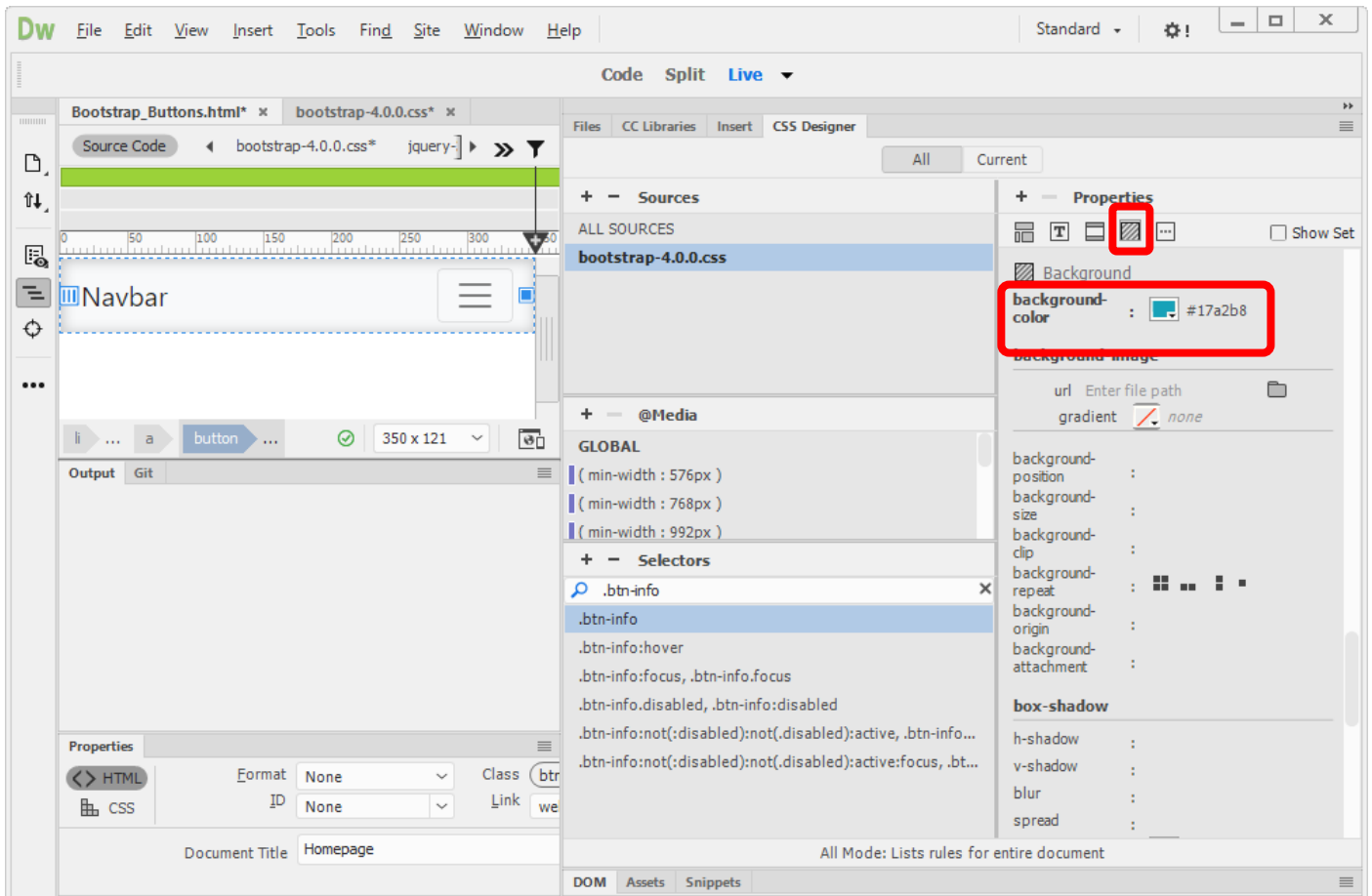
*If you haven't already it is probably worth saving your navigation bar!*

### STEP 10 – CUSTOMISING BUTTON COLOUR

*Using the in-built buttons means you've already got a rollover but for the next step you need to make sure you know which type of button you chose as it will help find the correct class in the Selector window!*



- Type the name of the **Class Selector** in the **Selector Window**
- Make sure it is highlighted and then press the **Background** button



- Change the colour to the one you want to use (either by typing the Hexadecimal code which can be created using [https://www.w3schools.com/colors/colors\\_hexadecimal.asp](https://www.w3schools.com/colors/colors_hexadecimal.asp) or using the selector)
- Now change the hover colour by searching the relevant selector, in the case of the info button it is **.btn-info:hover**
