RAIN (CREATE YOURSELF)

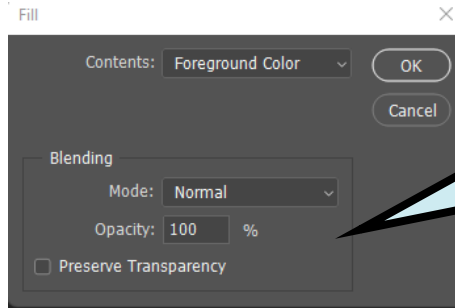
1. Once you've opened your image, create a new layer



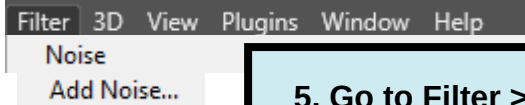
2. Make sure the foreground colour is black



3. Go to Edit > Fill

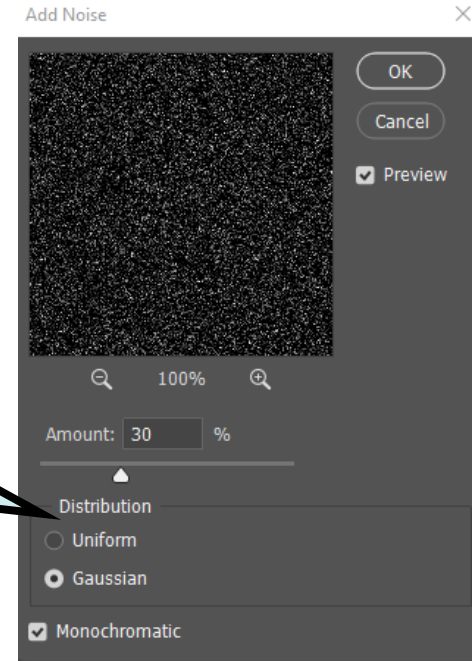


4. Make sure the settings are like this

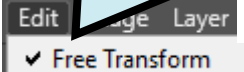


5. Go to Filter > Noise > Add Noise

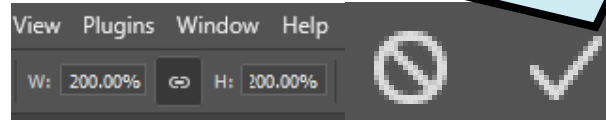
6. Make sure the settings are like this:
Amount: 30%
Gaussian: Select it
Monochromatic: Ticked



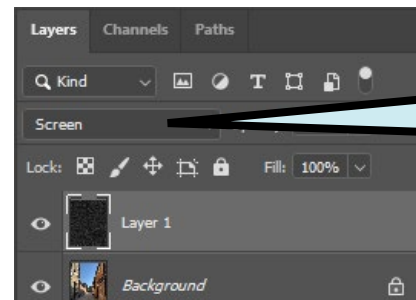
7. Either Press Ctrl/Cmd+T or go to Edit > Free Transform



8. Change both the width and the height to 200% and press the tick to the right on the same toolbar



9. In the Layers Panel, change the Blending to Screen
